It's ok to dry it out and throw it in the garbage.


Pour a thin layer in a box lined with a garbage bag. Newspaper or kitty litter will help absorb more paint in the box. When the paint in the box is dry, pour in another layer of paint until the can is empty. Discard the dried paint in the garbage.

Make sure to take the lid off before throwing the empty can in the garbage.
