- Date of Original Organization - April 18, 1871
- Public Utility Owned by the City of Milwaukee, Enterprise Fund of the City of Milwaukee
- Eleven wholesale customers who operate their own utility: Brown Deer, Butler, Greendale, Menomonee Falls, Mequon, Milwaukee County Grounds, New Berlin, Shorewood, Thiensville, Wauwatosa, West Allis
- Five retail customers, Greenfield, Hales Corners, St. Francis, Franklin (a portion) receive full utility service including water, distribution system maintenance, billing and customer service. West Milwaukee receives billing services but maintains its own distribution system.
