

Application for WAVE Rate – New Customer

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) has designed an Economic Development Rate (EDR), also known as the WAVE Rate (Water Attracting Valued Employers), to encourage business growth. Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) is authorized to offer discounted water rates to new and existing business customers in Milwaukee for a period of five years in exchange for increased water usage and living-wage job creation. Customers must begin taking service under the EDR before Feb. 8, 2013. (Milwaukee Water Works Rate File PSCW Authorization 3720-WR-107)

A customer requesting the EDR is required to complete this application and abide by the conditions as described below.

I acknowledge by signing this application for WAVE Rate that:

- Customer must file the attached affidavit affirming they would not be increasing water usage by the amount described but for the availability of the EDR. Customer must sign and notarize both application and affidavit.
- Customer will be disqualified from the EDR if minimum water usage requirements are not met for any four consecutive monthly billing periods.
- Within 90 days of EDR approval, customer must create at least 25 new living-wage jobs in the MWW service area and retain them throughout the 60-month period of EDR eligibility. The living-wage is established by the City of Milwaukee. In 2011, the living-wage rate is \$8.80/hour. Customer receiving the EDR must submit annual reports to MWW as to the level of jobs created and retained each month. Customer will be disqualified from the EDR if the average number of new living-wage jobs falls below 25 during any nine-month period.

4. Customer applying for the EDR must submit to MWW a water use and efficiency plan, estimating expected water uses by type and quantity, and demonstrate they have implemented the cost-effective, industry best management practices for water use efficiency. If the annual audit by MWW finds water use and efficiency plan is not in place and after 90 days, customer fails to implement a plan, customer is disqualified from receiving the EDR. 5. Irrigation and cooling water are not eligible for the EDR and will be billed at applicable nonresidential general service rates. Customers must, at their own expense, install plumbing for a secondary meter or meters to measure the use of this water separately. Plumbing permits are available from the City of Milwaukee Development Center, (414) 286-8208.
6. For expansions of service that require MWW or Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) to increase treatment, storage, or distribution capacity, the customer shall contribute the capital cost of the incremental capacity to MWW or MMSD. Customers shall be responsible for water main extensions and service lateral installations as provided in MWW current tariff Schedules Lc-1 and X-1.
7. For a new customer, all water usage is eligible for the EDR for a one-time period of 60 months. The rate applies only to the volumetric use; normal water service charges apply. Customers are billed monthly.

8. Customers who cease to qualify for the EDR before the 60 months are completed will be liable for the difference between the rate paid under the EDR and the applicable nonresidential general service rates the customer would have otherwise paid for the most recent 24 months the customer was served under the EDR.
