## Ald. Joe Davis Named To National League Of Cities Nominating Committee

Milwaukee Common Council member Joe Davis, Sr., has been appointed to the National League of Cities' (NLC) nominating committee by 2009 NLC President, Kathleen Novak, mayor of Northglenn, Colorado. The committee is responsible for recommending a slate of officers and board members to lead the NLC in 2010.

The Nominating Committee will meet in San Antonio, Texas in November of this year at the annual Congress of Cities & Exposition to review and recommend the board and officer candidates.

Ald. Davis, who is the chair of the Common Council's Community and Economic Development Committee, currently serves on the NLC Board of Directors. He has held multiple positions with the National League of Cities and has been an active leader in the organization, serving as past chair of the NLC's Community and Economic Development Policy and Advocacy Steering Committee and currently serving as a member of the NLC's International Council for 2009.
