Construction Project Moves Quickly

Road Work on W. Silver Spring Dr. to be Completed During Evening Hours

The county road project on Silver Spring Dr. has entered its final phases and is nearing completion. Beginning on October 6, 2009 repairs will be made to W. Silver Spring Dr. between N. 118th St. and approximately a quarter of a mile east of state highway 100.

Lanes will close beginning at 7 p.m. in the evening and reopen at 7 a.m. each morning through October 11, 2009.

“I’m happy that this part of the project will move so quickly, but want residents to be aware that the road repair work will take place primarily at night and traffic congestion will begin in the evenings after the rush hour,” Ald. Bohl said.

The county-sponsored project has been accomplished in several phases. “This portion of Silver Spring has needed attention for some time and we look forward to the end result as the project finally nears completion,” Ald. Bohl said.
