President Hines, Residents Mourn Loss of “Querro” Evans

Early this morning, 22-year-old Querronacesam “Querro” Evans was shot and killed at the corner of N. 35th Street and W. Garfield Avenue. The victim had attended junior college and shown promise in both academics and athletics.

“My thoughts and prayers are definitely with the Evans family, as well as all of the victim’s friends and neighbors who are trying to work through this tragedy,” said Common Council President Willie L. Hines, Jr., alderman for the 15th District. “I understand that District Three police personnel have worked diligently for much of last night and today. I commend them for their efforts, and I am grateful for the many law-abiding residents in the area for cooperating with police in their investigation.”

In addition to the ongoing police work, the City of Milwaukee and Pres. Hines will continue to work with citizens to ensure the safety and security of their neighborhood. “There are outstanding neighbors around 35th and Garfield who have made significant investments – both financially and personally – to see the area thrive,” added Pres. Hines. “This senseless loss of life is tragic on many different levels. I know the neighborhood will not stand idly by – residents will not tolerate this violence, and neither will I.”
