# How the State Budget and Residency Bill will Affect Milwaukee

*Public meeting tonight hosted by Alderman Terry Witkowski and State Representative  
Mark Honadel, residency bill sponsor*

**Alderman Terry Witkowski** will host a public meeting at 6:30 p.m. **TONIGHT (Monday, April 4)** at Victory School, 2222 W. Henry Ave., related to the proposed biennial budget and residency issues before the state Legislature. The proposal (Senate Bill 30) to lift residency requirements for Milwaukee firefighters and police officers is sponsored by **Rep. Mark Honadel**, and he will explain and discuss the bill. Alderman Witkowski will also discuss the bill's potential impact on the City of Milwaukee.

"We will each be discussing the ramifications of this legislation and the public will be invited to comment briefly after the discussion," said Alderman Witkowski.
