2011 Garden Awards

## NOMINATION RULES

The 2011 Residential Garden Awards have been updated for this year. Please take note of the following items when considering whether to nominate someone.

- Awards for 2011 are based on curb appeal. Front yards only. Judges will be viewing the property from the street and their score will be based on how the property appears to the average passerby.
- Nominated properties must be within the boundaries of The Garden District (13th Aldermanic District) and be designed, installed and maintained by amateur gardeners. Exceptions include the installation of trees and/or hardscapes (such as fencing and raised beds).
- Awards will be given for First, Second, and Third Place as well as categories for most improved, and great places in small spaces.
- All award recipients must agree to display the "Garden Awards" yard sign throughout the growing season.
- Nomination forms must be postmarked by Friday July 15th. Judging will take place July 16th to July 24th.
- Nominees will be notified after July 24th with additional information. All Nominees grant the Garden District use of images of their garden in publications without compensation.
