Police traffic stop race data to be discussed at committee

A representative from the Milwaukee Police Department will present a report Thursday to the Common Council's **Public Safety Committee** detailing the racial information being collected during police traffic stops. The **committee meets tomorrow at 9 a.m. in room 301-B at City Hall, 200 E. Wells St**

The information is contained in a report that is provided to the committee annually by the MPD. Last year **Alderman Milele A. Coggs** sponsored successful legislation (Council file #110387) urging Milwaukee police to continue collecting information about the race of persons involved in police traffic stops – that after the state budget repealed a state law requiring law enforcement agencies to collect such information. The Council measure was co-sponsored by **Alderman Willie C. Wade** and **Alderman Nik Kovac**.
