Public's help requested to apprehend armed robber

Statement from Alderman Joe Davis, Sr.

July 11, 2013

In cooperation with the Milwaukee Police Department, I am asking for the public's help in locating a man who has been robbing businesses along N. 76th St. at knifepoint.

MPD's District Four has indicated that the suspect they are looking for is a dark skinned black male, in his 20s, straight teeth, slim build, about 160-170lbs., low hair cut, and scruffy facial hair. **Please see the attached photo.**

The suspect has targeted businesses along N. 76th Street from W. Silver Spring Dr. to W. Good Hope Rd.

The man has been seen wearing a red hoodie with red letters (DGK) on a white background, on the front of the hoodie. He also had on light faded jeans, and wears a silver chain hanging from his belt.

Typically the suspect enters the business armed with an 8-inch kitchen knife and demands money. He has then been seen getting into a silver vehicle (on the passenger side), possibly a Dodge Intrepid.
