Listening sessions planned, input sought for new Mill Road Library

Alderman Robert W. Puente invites members of the community to participate in a pair of listening sessions intended to share information and gather input on the proposed plan for a new Mill Road Library.

The Milwaukee Public Library Board of Trustees has expressed interest in proposed plans to replace the existing Mill Road Library (6431 N. 76th St.) from a developer team including Maures Development, Common Bond and Engberg Anderson. The proposal features up to 46 units of affordable housing, a 15,000 square-foot library on the first floor, dedicated on-site parking for library users, green space and a potential 2,500 square-foot commercial space on a city-owned parcel at 7717 W. Good Hope Rd.

Several proposals were presented to the public at a meeting in December, and plans were put on hold by the Library Board of Directors in order to gather more community input. Residents are urged to attend meetings on **Thursday, February 26** and **Wednesday, March 4** to learn new details about the project and offer additional input.
