Public Safety Committee holds special meeting with Milwaukee County District Attorney's office

The Milwaukee Common Council's Public Safety Committee will hold the second in a series of special meetings at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, featuring a discussion with Milwaukee County District Attorney John Chisholm and his office.

Each in the series of meetings (schedule attached) is intended to examine the role of a different facet of the public safety process, committee chair **Ald. Bob Donovan** said, offering civic leaders the opportunity to join the fray and take collaborative action.
