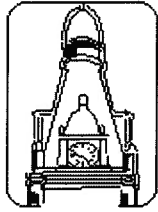

PRINCIPAL EXPENSE STATEMENT



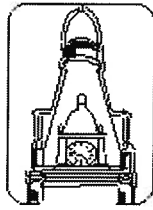
