To Apply For a Transitional Job With the City You Must:



Reside within the following area: (N. Sherman Blvd. on the west, W. Silver Spring Dr. on the north, I-43 on the east, W. Mitchell Street on the south).

Be 18 - 64 years old at the time of enrollment. If 24 years of age or older, **MUST** be the biological, adoptive or primary relative caregiver of a child under the age of 18.



Have one of the following:
a child support order
a child welfare reunification plan
be an ex-offender



Not be receiving W-2 benefits and not be eligible to receive Unemployment Insurance Compensation.



Have been unemployed for the last four (4) consecutive calendar weeks prior to enrollment.



Have an annual household income that is less than 150% of the federal poverty guideline for the household size.
