Resolution regarding a contract for economic development research .

Whereas, The Redevelopment Authority recently entered into a contract with Vandewalle and Associates to identify economic development strategies for the 30th Street industrial corridor, and

Whereas, The State of Wisconsin Office of Energy Independence seeks to partner with the Redevelopment Authority in efforts to pinpoint opportunities to grow businesses and jobs related to the emerging waste-to-energy technology sector in Milwaukee, and

Whereas, The State of Wisconsin Office of Energy Independence seeks to enter into a contract with the Redevelopment Authority to undertake research that evaluates technology and identifies pilot innovative waste-to-energy strategies, and

Whereas, Such research may identify job-creating opportunities that are appropriate for redevelopment areas such as the 30th Street industrial corridor and the Menomonee Valley; now, therefore be it

Resolved, That the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee enter into a contract not to exceed \$50,000 with the State of Wisconsin Office of Energy Independence to identify waste-to-energy business and job creation opportunities in Milwaukee, with funds being provided by the Office of Energy Independence, and be it


Further Resolved, That the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee enter into a sub-contract with Vandewalle and Associates to complete the research by May 1, 2009, following development of a comprehensive scope of services, and be it

Further Resolved, That staff of the Redevelopment Authority is directed to provide a report to the Authority regarding the findings of the research following its completion.
