Resolution authorizing a contract for compliance monitoring services at the former Tower Automotive property

Whereas, On July 14, 2009, the Redevelopment Authority authorized resolution number 10106 for the acquisition of 84 acres of the former Tower Automotive facility located in the 35th and Capitol (Century City) Redevelopment Project Area; and

Whereas, On September 17, 2009, the Authority authorized resolution number 10131 approving and authorizing the solicitation of proposals for compliance monitoring services at the former Tower Automotive site; and

Whereas, The Authority issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) for Compliance Monitoring Services for EBE/RPP/LEB Programs, Wage Requirements, and Apprenticeship/On-The-Job Training Goals on October 19, 2009 and received multiple qualified respondents; and

Whereas, The respondent's proposals were reviewed by the Bid Committee and a recommendation was made to the Executive Director for Prism Technical Management and Marketing Services, LLC; and

Whereas, The Authority's compliance monitoring services contract is anticipated to last two years. The contract will be evaluated at the end of two years to determine if an extension is necessary; and


Whereas, The compliance monitoring services will be paid for using funds associated with Tax Incremental District No. 74; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee, that the Executive Director is authorized to execute a contract compliance monitoring services at the former Tower Automotive site.
