Mayer & Durner Buildings

North Third Street Historic District
 2002 – 2008 N. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive

These two buildings were given local historic designation in 1987. George Durner built or remodeled the corner building in 1883. Herman Mayer built the adjacent building, designed by Henry Messmer, in 1891. After several changes of ownership and periods of vacancy, Kenneth Sidello acquired the property and worked to rehabilitate the buildings and install appropriate storefronts that closely approximate the originals. The Mayer and Durner buildings are now once again a pair of outstanding commercial buildings that help define the unique character of King Drive.
