What is the Community Improvement Project match grant?

NIDC CIP match grants support community projects that engage community members and physically improve neighborhoods in Milwaukee. CIP grants are reimbursable grants that require a dollar-for-dollar match from non-City funding sources. The maximum CIP grant request is \$4,000.

Since 2015, all CIP applicants are required to attend an orientation session before applying for an NIDC CIP match grant. Please note: CIP matching grants are not awarded for individual home improvement projects.
