

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

## **DEAR PROPERTY OWNER:**

The Common Council has referred file number 111381 to the City Plan Commission for recommendation. This file relates to the change in zoning from Industrial Office (IO2) to Industrial Mixed (IM), to expand permitted uses, for lands located on the west side of South 13th Street, south of West Cleveland Avenue, in the 14th Aldermanic District. This zoning change was requested by the Alex Torbica and the Maric Family Trust, and would allow for additional permitted uses for an existing, multi-story building located at 2745 South 13th Street. The 30,000 square foot building was utilized by a telephone utility company for approximately 20 years, and most recently housed the Bureau of Milwaukee Child Welfare facility until 2010. The building has been vacant for approximately 13 months. The owner has stated that there has been interest in utilizing the existing building for community-supporting services or residential uses, both of which are not permitted under the IO2 zoning. **Please refer to the reverse side of this notice for map details.**


