RiverWalk

To capitalize on interest in the river as a destination for living, shopping, and vacationing, the Historic Third Ward Association, Business Improvement District and the City of Milwaukee created a Third Ward RiverWalk, which connects to the Downtown RiverWalk. Built from Ipe wood, a tropical hardwood, the boardwalk has won several design awards including a 2007 American Institute of Architects Honor Award for Regional and Urban Design.



Erie Street Plaza

Erie Street Plaza will be a landmark public plaza at Milwaukee's harbor entrance. A design competition was held in 2006 to generate ideas for the plaza, which will link the Milwaukee RiverWalk to the lakefront. Construction began in late 2009.



Lakeshore State Park

Lakeshore State Park provides unique urban recreational opportunities, including boat docks and fishing access. A multi-use trail encircles the park and will connect to the Hank Aaron State Trail and the Milwaukee County Park's Oak Leaf Trail in the future.
