


# Recent Development in the Washington Park Plan Area June 2010



**Former Finney Library**  
4243 West North Avenue

Wisconsin Lutheran College has made an offer to purchase the former Finney Library property from the City of Milwaukee. The College would pay \$125,000 plus one-half of the Phase II environmental testing cost. This 9,000 square foot building has been empty since the new Washington Park Library at 2121 North Sherman Boulevard opened in 2003. Wisconsin Lutheran College intends to move their Pathways to College programs for youth and parents from their Bluemound Road campus to this location. Total project development costs are expected to be \$850,000.



**Washington Park Apartments**  
3910 West Lisbon Avenue

United Methodist Children's Services completed construction of this seven million dollar, 24 unit apartment complex in December 2009. All units have 3 bedrooms, and 10 units offer permanent supportive housing for families in which a parent struggles with mental illness. The building provides an array of on-site services including day care, parenting classes, nutrition programs, a food pantry, and a family resource center.



**Urban Ecology Center**  
4145 West Lisbon Avenue

The Urban Ecology Center opened a satellite center in Washington Park in the fall of 2007. Located in a portion of the park pavilion on the lagoon, the Center offers after-school programs, summer camps, canoeing, fishing, bird-watching and other outdoor adventure and environmental activities.
