

Lead Risk Assessment Information

If the Health Department has provided a Lead Risk Assessment for a property, this document is available on the real estate web site by clicking on the “Lead Risk Assessment” link located by the property address (next to the scope of work). This document contains detailed information about lead paint risk assessment. Please note that this risk assessment is strictly interior and exterior property structure and does not include any lead pipe testing.

In targeted neighborhoods with a high risk of lead problems, the Milwaukee Health Department can provide resources to abate lead hazards in windows when the property owner bears the cost of other abatement. Funding is available through the Primary Prevention Funding. After closing has occurred and the real estate section has received documentation confirming that ownership has been transferred, the new buyers will be sent the application needed to apply for a Lead Grant.
