

City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works Special Event Permit Fees

Fees Effective 1/01/2010

Excerpted from sec. 81, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances

Class A event (requiring 100 or more police service hours; additional fee of \$335 per day for each additional day beyond the third day)	\$3,700
Class B event (25 to 99 police service hours)	400
Class C event (1 to 24 police service hours)	110
Class D event (no hours of police service; fees may be applicable for equipment)	0

MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT SETS THE CLASSIFICATION FOR EACH EVENT. CLASSIFICATION IS NOT DETERMINED BY THE PERMITTEE.

By ordinance, applicants for Class A, B and C events must furnish with the application fee an original certificate of insurance which provides minimum combined single limits for bodily injury and property damage of \$1,000,000, naming the City of Milwaukee as additional insured.

For profit and non-profit organizations, including taverns and churches, are charged equipment fees for block parties, special events and banner/flag displays. There is no charge for block parties held by private citizens or for block club parties related to neighborhood cleanups or litter pickups.
