

## **Public Notice of FFY 2018-20 City of Milwaukee Downtown Streetcar DBE Goals**

The City of Milwaukee has authorized release to the public of the draft proposed Triennial (2018-2020) DBE Goals for the Milwaukee Downtown Streetcar, a Federal Transit Administration (FTA) assisted project, for a 45-day comment period. The City of Milwaukee currently proposes DBE goals of 18.0% for professional services, 18.5% for construction and 5.0% for operations. A final, overall percentage will be determined upon further review of the expected expenditures in all categories.

The final DBE goal will be applicable to federally-assisted contracts scheduled to be solicited and awarded during the period of October 1, 2017, through September 30, 2020.

The City of Milwaukee currently proposes to meet 100% of its overall goal utilizing race-conscious measures in accordance with Title 49 CFR Part 26.51.

Upon completion of the 45-day public comment period for the proposed DBE goal, The City of Milwaukee will review all public comments and seek final approval of the DBE Goals and Methodology.

The City of Milwaukee's proposed DBE Goal and rationale (developed in response to USDOT's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program Regulations published under Title 49 CFR Part 26, the FTA Master Agreement and Federal Register/Vol. 75, No. 22 [Docket No. OST-2010-0021], February 3, 2010, rules and regulations) is available for inspection and public review for 45 days following the date of this Notice, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Central Standard Time, Monday through Friday, at:
