

- PLAN YOUR ROUTE TO USE RIGHT TURNS WHENEVER POSSIBLE



Idle diesel engines only when they have been doing heavy work in the last 15 minutes. Then idle the engine only 5 minutes to cool down the turbocharger.

Idling a cold diesel engine wastes fuel and pollutes the atmosphere.

Recent studies have shown that right turns are safer. In addition, right turns reduce waiting time at intersections and waiting for upcoming traffic, thus reducing idle time and fuel.

- DON'T IDLE YOUR ENGINE
- STICK TO THE SPEED LIMIT
- AVOID JACKRABBIT STARTS
- CONSOLIDATE YOUR TRIPS
- CARPOOL WHENEVER POSSIBLE
- CHECK YOUR TIRES FOR INFLATION
- DON'T OVERLOAD YOUR VEHICLE
- BRING YOUR VEHICLE IN ON TIME FOR PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE
