The City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works (DPW) is inviting you to attend a public information meeting providing information regarding the proposed improvements along Vliet Street between North 27th Street and North 12th Street. The construction for this project is currently scheduled for 2017.

The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, September 29 from 4 - 6 p.m.** at Martin Luther King Center located at 1531 W. Vliet St., Milwaukee, WI 53205. The meeting will follow an informal open house format, with representatives and consultants from the DPW and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) available to answer questions.

It is very important that we receive public input on the proposed project as it will be directly impacting businesses and residents in the area. Please let us know if you think your property may have a hollow sidewalk that would be impacted by construction. As required by the Section 106 process indicated in the WisDOT Facilities Development Manual for archeological/historical review, this notice serves as formal notification for this project to persons with a concern for or knowledge about historic buildings, structures, and archeological sites located along the project. Such persons are encouraged to attend this meeting or provide comments to the City of Milwaukee. Input that is received at the public information meeting will assist in completing the proposed design. Additionally, the meeting will give the public an opportunity to ask questions regarding the project.
