South 27th Street Construction Project: West Howard Avenue to the Bridge Over the Union Pacific Railroad (Dakota Street)

The South 27th Street construction project is scheduled to begin on Monday, March 17, 2014. Estimated completion date for the project is November 15, 2014. The project will consist of removing the existing pavement and reconstructing with concrete pavement. Each 36-foot roadway will be widened by two feet to provide a bicycle accommodation. Bike lanes will not be marked, except from Oklahoma Avenue north to the Union Pacific Rail Road. New curb and gutter, driveway approaches and sidewalks will be constructed at most locations.

A public information meeting has been scheduled to discuss the details and impacts of the project.
