

Milwaukee City Hall – Foundation Restoration Construction Progress Update #10 –May 6, 2017

On Saturday, May 6, 2017, access to Market Street from Kilbourn Avenue will be completely closed. Vehicle access to Market Street and Lower Parking of the Zeidler Municipal Building will be from East Wells Street going westbound only. The construction staging area currently located at the south end of North Market Street will be relocated to the north end of Market Street, near the intersection with E. Kilbourn Avenue, as Phase 2 of the City Hall Foundation Restoration Project moves to the northeast quadrant of the building. The relocated staging area will be separated from public areas by fencing and barricades. Vehicle and pedestrian traffic, parking on N. Market St., and City Hall access points will be affected as follows:

Market Street – Wells Street to Kilbourn Avenue:

- *Vehicular access to Market Street from Kilbourn Avenue will be closed.*
- Vehicular access to Market Street for the Zeidler Municipal Garage Lower Parking and on-street ADA parking will now be **from E. Wells Street going westbound ONLY**. Drivers will have **right-turn-only** access from E. Wells St. onto Market Street. Drivers leaving Market St. will have **right-turn-only** access to E. Wells St. going westbound
- The Market St. entrance to City Hall will remain open
- On-street ADA parking will be available on the east side of Market St.
- Loading Zone access will be provided on the west side of Market Street.
- The pedestrian sidewalk on the west side of Market St. from Kilbourn to the City Hall entrance will be closed
- The temporary sidewalk along the south side of Kilbourn between Market and Water streets will remain open

Building Entrances and Perimeter Sidewalks and Crosswalks

- Sidewalks and crosswalks around City Hall will be modified as described above to maintain access and egress for the three main entrances of City Hall.
- Pedestrian pathways along Water Street will remain in current condition.
- Please refer to the updated City Hall Sidewalk and Crosswalk Access Plan for more information.

City Hall Bus Stop

- No new changes. The Milwaukee County Transit Bus Stop #738 (City Hall) will remain in the island in the Southeast corner of the intersection of Wells Street and Water Street.

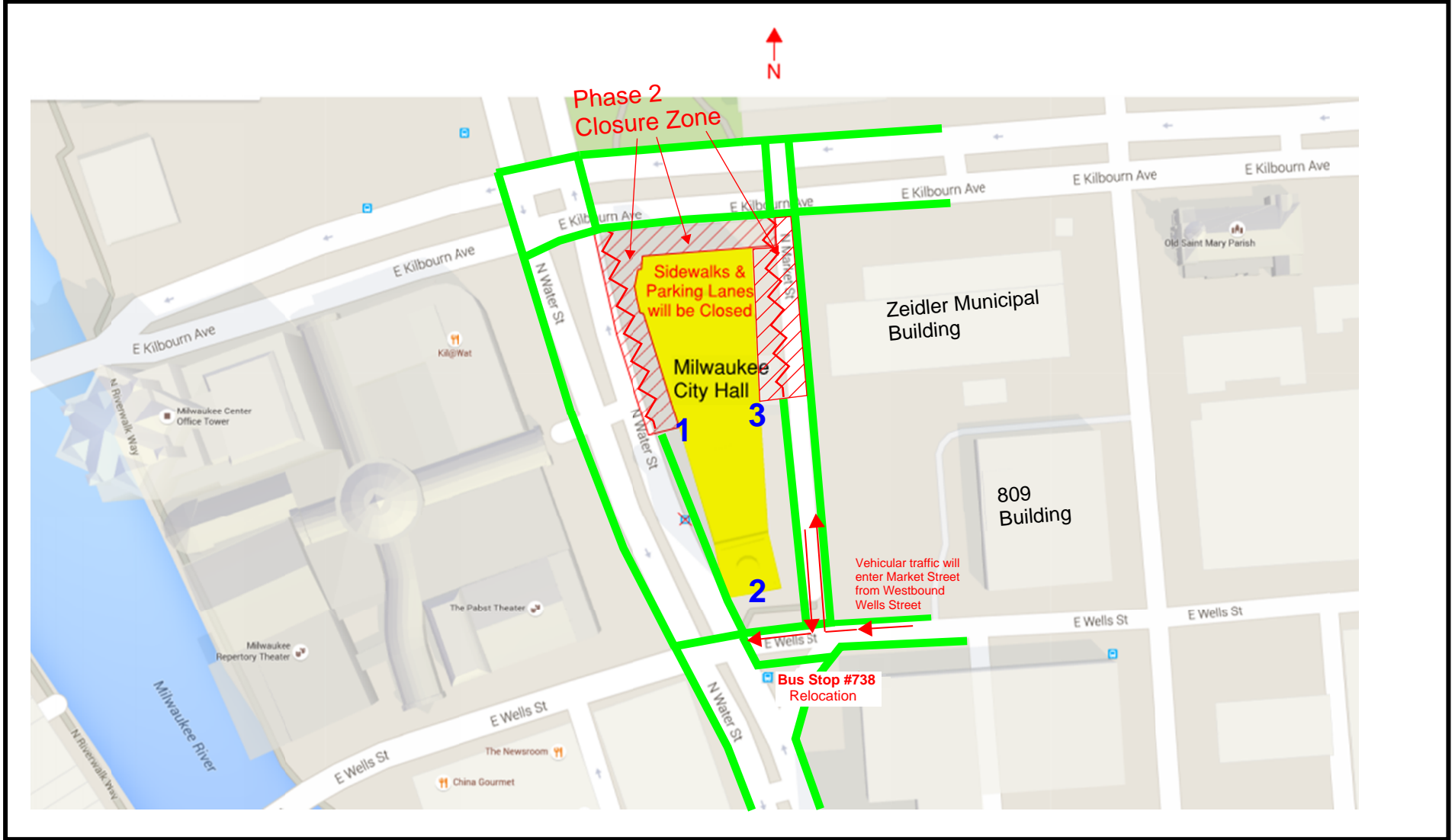
