**Department of Public Works Services
For the Independence Day Holiday Weekend**

City of Milwaukee government offices will be closed on Friday, July 3, 2015 in celebration of the Independence Day holiday. However, some Department of Public Works (DPW) services will be available for limited hours of operation and certain parking restrictions will be lifted.

Garbage, Recycling, and Self-Help Centers:

- There will be no garbage and recycling pick-up on Friday, July 3
- Self-Help Centers will be closed on July 3 and 4, and open on Sunday, July 5 from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Parking Enforcement:

- **No parking meter enforcement** on Saturday, July 4
- **No overnight parking enforcement** Friday night into Saturday morning (July 4 from 2:00 to 6:00 a.m.), and Saturday night into Sunday morning (July 5 from 2:00 to 6:00 a.m.)
- **Overnight parking enforcement resumes** on Sunday night into Monday morning (July 6 from 2:00 to 6:00 a.m.)

- **OPEN:** Friday, July 3 and Saturday, July 4 – 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon
- **CLOSED:** Sunday, July 5
