### **Repaving Project on East Michigan Street to Impact Traffic and Parking Patterns**

*Project begins Tuesday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2013*

Beginning Tuesday, September 10, East Michigan Street from North Water Street to North Van Buren Street will be repaved. The project involves grinding off the existing asphalt surface, and replacing it with a new asphalt pavement. New traffic lines, crosswalks, and parking lines will also be added.

Traffic will be affected as follows:

- The westbound lanes of E. Michigan St. will be closed on September 10<sup>th</sup>
- Two-way traffic will be maintained in the eastbound lanes – one lane in each direction
- When repaving is completed on the westbound lanes, the eastbound lanes will be closed, and two-way traffic will switch to the newly paved westbound lanes
- Intersection/driveway access will be maintained except during paving and marking operations

There will be no on-street parking along this corridor during repaving.

This project is scheduled to be completed by Friday, September 13, but as this schedule is weather dependent, repairs may take longer if rain delays or interrupts work.
