Winter Parking Regulations End Wednesday, March 2

Winter parking regulations for the City of Milwaukee expire on Wednesday, March 2, 2016. Residents must still follow winter parking rules overnight Tuesday, March 1 into Wednesday morning, March 2. With measurable snow forecasted for February 29/March 1, these rules will allow the Department of Public Works (DPW) to clear the streets effectively, efficiently, and most importantly - safely.

In addition, residents are reminded that DPW can still declare a snow emergency, the “4-inch rule”, or an overnight snow removal operation after March 1.

DPW encourages vehicle owners to sign up to receive a **Snow Mobile Winter Text Alert** message at milwaukee.gov/mpw . Subscribers will receive a text message on their cell phone(s) alerting them that a DPW operation has been called.



Prefer an email message? Sign up through E-Notify at milwaukee.gov/mpw to receive an email with the same DPW information when a snow operation is declared.
