



West Lloyd Street North 60th Street to West Lisbon Avenue

The project is managed by the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works (DPW) in conjunction with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

Start Date: April 25, 2016 • Anticipated Completion: October 2016

Project Overview:

This project will consist of removing the existing roadway and replacing it with concrete pavement. All curbs, gutters, driveway approaches, and sidewalks will be replaced. The roadway width will remain 40 feet between North 47th and North 60th streets. The roadway width between North 46th Street and West Lisbon Avenue will be changed from two 32-foot median-divided roadways to one 37-foot westbound roadway and one 29-foot eastbound roadway. The roadway will be divided by a 6-foot wide median. The roadway design will eliminate parking on the south side of the road, and reduce driving lane widths from 12 feet to 11 feet to provide a 5-foot striped bicycle lane in each direction. Sidewalks will be added to the south side of West Lloyd Street from North 46th Street to West Lisbon Avenue, adjacent to Washington Park.

Traffic*

The paving project will be constructed in two stages to allow for through traffic on West Lloyd Street during construction:

- Stage 1: One-way traffic will be maintained on the south side of the roadway in the eastbound lane between North 47th and North 60th streets. Two-way traffic will be maintained between North 47th Street and West Lisbon Avenue.
- Stage 2: One-way traffic will be maintained on the north side of the roadway in the westbound lane from North 47th Street to North 60th Street. Two-way traffic will be maintained from North 47th Street to West Lisbon Avenue.

**Some aspects of the staging may change due to other construction projects occurring in the area.*

Parking

On-street parking will not be available during construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained to abutting properties and businesses during construction with the least amount of inconvenience. City staff and the contractor will work to minimize the amount of time any driveway access is restricted, and will notify the property owner 48 hours in advance of any driveway work.

Working Hours

Work is allowed from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The contractor cannot work on weekends without prior approval from the Department of Public Works.



Communication and Contact Information

The City of Milwaukee will have staff overseeing various portions of the work:

- **Construction Supervisor:** Will address contractor concerns
- **Project Inspectors:** Will be on-site fulltime to oversee the contractor's work and ensure that the concerns of the public and businesses are being addressed.
- **Support for Business Liaison (SBL):** Will provide information about the construction, share timelines and procedures via construction updates with businesses and other key organizations. The SBL also coordinates with the construction supervisor and project inspector to resolve concerns from businesses and residents.
