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**West Hampton Avenue,
Teutonia Avenue to Green Bay
Avenue Completed**

In April 2015 Phase 2 of the West Hampton Avenue reconstruction project resumed. This final phase consisted of completing the south side of West Hampton Avenue between North 20th Street and North Teutonia Avenue. Bioswales were installed on the medians to reduce polluted rainwater from flowing into storm drains and sewers. Landscaping along the corridor was also completed.

As part of a recent federal mandate, bicycle lanes were added to the construction project, making it easier for bicyclists to travel along this major arterial thoroughfare.

New mast arm poles are being installed as part of the traffic signal work along the traffic corridor and will be completed soon.
