



South 13th Street, from West Forest Home Avenue to Windlake Avenue

Project Start: May 2016 / Anticipated Completion: September 2016

Project Overview

The project consists of removing the existing roadway and replacing it with concrete pavement. All curbs, gutters and driveway approaches will be replaced. Sidewalks will be replaced to a width of six feet except, wherever possible, sidewalks will be 8 feet wide based on additional space. All planter/furniture zones will be removed.

The roadway width will be widened from 40 feet to 48 feet to provide

- two 11-foot driving lanes
- two 8-foot parking lanes and
- two 5-foot bicycle lanes.

Traffic

The construction project will be done in two stages.

- **Phase 1:** May 31 through approximately July 11: Work will begin on the west half of the roadway with one lane of north bound traffic maintained on the east side of the roadway.
- **Phase 2:** July 11 through approximately September 12: Work will begin on the east half of the roadway. Two-way traffic, one lane in each direction, will be provided on the west side of the roadway.

Parking, Pedestrian and Driveway Access

On street parking will not be available during construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained to abutting properties and businesses during construction with the least amount of inconvenience. City staff and the contractor will work to minimize the amount of time any driveway access is restricted, and will notify the property owner 48 hours in advance of any driveway work.

Working Hours

Work is allowed from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The contractor cannot work on weekends without prior approval from the Department of Public Works.

The City of Milwaukee will have staff overseeing various portions of the work:


Project Engineer

also coordinates with the construction supervisor and project inspector to resolve concerns from businesses and residents.
