



## North 27th Street from West Highland Boulevard to West Lisbon Avenue

Anticipated Start: Week of July 18, 2016    Anticipated Completion Date: November 23, 2016

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### Project Overview

The project consists of resurfacing the roadway with asphalt pavement. The sidewalk, curb and gutter and driveway approaches will be replaced as necessary due to poor condition or grade differential. The roadway width will remain 36-foot wide on both sides of the 28-foot wide median. Once completed, the roadways will continue to provide two driving lanes, one bicycle lane in each direction and one parking lane on each side. The project will also include the reconstruction of the West Lisbon Avenue intersection on North 27th Street.

### Traffic

One lane of traffic shall be open for both northbound and southbound traffic on North 27th Street throughout the construction project. One lane of traffic shall also be open for both eastbound and westbound traffic during construction in the West Lisbon Avenue intersection.

### Parking, Pedestrian and Driveway Access

On street parking will not be available during construction.

Provisions will be made to ensure that pedestrian access will be maintained to abutting properties and businesses during construction with the least amount of convenience. City staff and the contractor will work to minimize the amount of time any driveway access is restricted.

### Working Hours

Work is allowed from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The contractor can work on weekends with prior approval from the Department of Public Works.

### Bus Route

The #27 and Purple Line will maintain operations during construction. Milwaukee County Transit will install temporary bus stop signs as necessary. During the construction project the **northbound and southbound bus stops at West McKinley Boulevard and West Galena Street will be closed.**

### Project Management

The project is managed by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation in conjunction with the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works (DPW)

### Project Construction Leader:

Will be on site full time to oversee the contractor's work and ensure that the concerns of the public and businesses are being addressed.

### Construction Supervisor:

Will address contractor concerns.

### Support for Business Liaison (SBL):

Will provide information about the construction project, and share timelines and procedures via construction updates with businesses and other key organizations. The SBL coordinates with the Project Construction Leader and the Construction Leader.
