

Fire Department

Between January 1, 2012 and June 30, 2012, the Milwaukee Fire Department (MFD) reported three fire fatalities and twenty-three civilian fire injuries. During this same time period, MFD made 1,751 fire responses, 3,901 rescue responses, and 591 service responses.



During the first six months of 2012, MFD responded to 13,667 ALS (Advanced Life Support) calls and 14,838 BLS (Basic Life Support) calls. MFD personnel made contact with 54,771 individuals regarding fire safety and distributed 805 smoke detectors to households that did not have a working smoke detector.

Between January 1, 2012 and June 30, 2012, the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) reported a 2.2% increase in violent crime and a 6.4% decrease in property crime compared to the first six months of 2011. All violent crimes, except for aggravated assault, decreased, and all property crimes, except for arson, also decreased.





FPC 2012 Mid-Year Brochure

- Between January 1, 2012 and June 30, 2012, 82 informal complaints and 58 formal complaints were filed with the FPC. In comparison, during the first six months of 2011, 72 informal complaints and 39 formal complaints were filed.
- Of the 140 complaints filed thus far in 2012, 17 formal complaints were open and remained under investigation, while 41 formal complaints were closed. 81 of 82 informal complaints were closed.
- The most common formal complaint allegations included department procedures and discourtesy; while the most common informal complaint allegations included department procedures and department services. Two complaints contained no allegations.
- Police District 7, with 19 formal complaints and 26 informal complaints, was the district with the most complaints.
- A total of 153 employees of the Milwaukee Police Department had complaints filed against them. Of these 85.6% were male and 14.4% were female.
- June, with 30 total complaints, and May with 29 complaints, were the months with the most complaints filed. January and February were the months with the fewest complaints filed, 18 and 12 respectively.
- 74 complainants were female (52.1%), while 68 complainants were male (47.9%).
