Disciplinary Appeal Hearing

This is to advise you that the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners will meet at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 22, 2015, as well as at 1:30 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2015, for the purpose of continuing a hearing on the appeal of Christopher Manney from discipline imposed. Sunday's hearing will be held in Branch 1 of the Municipal Court, 951 N. James Lovell Street. Monday's hearing will be held in the Koeppen-Gerlach Auditorium of Centennial Hall, Milwaukee Public Library, 733 N. 8th Street.

The Board may receive a motion to conduct a closed session pursuant to Section 19.85 (1)(a) and (c) Wis. Stats. for the purpose of conducting deliberations regarding these matters. Upon conclusion of the aforesaid closed session, the Board will reconvene in open session to announce its decision. Should that decision require additional testimony, such testimony will be received in open session. Deliberations thereafter may be conducted in closed session upon motion pursuant to Section 19.85 (1)(a) and (c) Wis. Stats., after which the Board will reconvene in open session and announce its final decision.

Be further advised that one or more members of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners who are not on the hearing panel may be in attendance at the hearing which, together with the hearing panel, would constitute a quorum of the Fire and Police Commission. However, no regular business of the Commission shall be conducted during the aforementioned hearing, and any Commissioner not on the hearing panel will have no participation in the deliberations and decision of the hearing panel.
