Seating for the public will include reserved seating for the media and for the Hamilton and Manney parties. Once these individuals have been seated, the remaining capacity of the public area will be filled with members of the public. Efforts will be made to balance the attendance of the supporters of each of the two parties. In order to preserve the integrity of the proceedings and to ensure the safety of all in attendance, capacity limits will be enforced and the public will not be permitted to loiter in the hallway for security and safety reasons.

All parties entering the Municipal Court building and Centennial Hall will pass through security, which includes a metal detector and an inspection of personal bags (e.g. purses or backpacks). Attendees are discouraged from bringing matches, lighters and similar items; such items will be collected by the security staff and the owners may obtain such items upon leaving the building.
