





PERSONNEL ORDER 2013 – 50

RE: DISCIPLINARY ACTION

POLICE OFFICER KURT D. KEZESKE, (009063), Second District, charged with violation of department Core Values as follows:

Core Value 1.00 – Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.05, referencing Standard Operating Procedures relating to Vehicle Pursuits, Section 660.20(A)(B): Failure to exercise due regard when engaging in a pursuit that violated department policy.

Core Value 3.00 - Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.11: Knowingly and with reckless disregard for the truth, making false statements to department investigators and supervisors.

Core Value 1.00 – Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.02: Lacking the capacity to enforce federal and state laws, and city ordinances.

The charges having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Failure to exercise due regard when engaging in a pursuit that violated department policy.

Discharged from the department.

Knowingly and with reckless disregard for the truth, making false statements to department investigators and supervisors.

Discharged from the department.

Lacking the capacity to enforce federal and state laws, and city ordinances.

Discharged from the department.

It is hereby ordered that POLICE OFFICER KURT D. KEZESKE be discharged from the department and removed from the payroll effective immediately pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 62.50(18).
