**WALKER ANNOUNCES RETURN OF 'MUSIC UNDER GLASS'
CONCERT SERIES AT THE DOMES**

MILWAUKEE – County Executive Scott Walker announces the Milwaukee County Parks kick off of the second annual after-hours “Music Under Glass” at the Mitchell Park Domes. Walker will introduce the opening concert featuring Eddie Butts on October 1. This five-month concert series is presented by Potawatomi Bingo & Casino.

The Mitchell Park Domes Concert Series runs from October 1 through November every Tuesday and Thursday evening from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Light shows will occur during the evening concert breaks and after performances. The concerts will continue with extended nighttime hours January through March 2010 in the beautifully restored Domes at 524 S. Layton Blvd.

For the price of admission, attendees will be entertained by live music, an awe-inspiring, computer-generated light show, and the option to tour all three Domes with their rare and exotic plant life from every continent on Earth. A total of 39 evenings are scheduled featuring quality music with diverse styles and artists. Food and beverages are available for purchase.

Opening night will be the first of several Blue Moon nights, where attendees can enjoy a 10’ blimp flying in the Show Dome and receive specials on Blue Moon products. Also new this year will be a live “video feed” of the bands in the lobby, where visitors can enjoy a night of camaraderie in the lobby and not miss the “live” concert going on in the Show Dome.

Families and children are welcome, yet “Music Under Glass” also provides an elegant and affordable escape for couples looking to relax and unwind in the evening. Walk along winding pathways in the Tropical Dome to the wooden bridge in front of a cascading 25-foot waterfall.
