Inmate Switches Wristband

A jail inmate being held on a probation violation for an auto theft warrant switched wristbands with an inmate held on a marijuana possession charge Sunday afternoon. The switch enabled 19-year-old Jaron X. Jennings to bail out on a misdemeanor marijuana charge. This was discovered when a corrections officer took inmate roll call on the next shift and noticed he had William Carter instead of Jaron Jennings in custody.

Identification wristbands are bar-coded and should be secure enough so inmates can't slip them over their hands. Carter and Jennings' wristbands were secured improperly. If anyone has information about the location of Jaron Jennings, they should call Milwaukee County Sheriff's detectives at (414) 278-4788.

This afternoon, a disgusted Milwaukee County Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. issued the following statement:

"Wristband switching is one of the oldest tricks in the books yet we have people working here that are still dumb enough to fall for it. However, they won't be here after I finish my investigation."
