## **CITY OF MILWAUKEE HEALTH DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES PLANS TO DISTRIBUTE REMAINING 1500 DOSES OF H1N1 VACCINE**

*Eligible residents are urged to download and complete consent form and bring with them to expedite registration process*

The City of Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) will hold an H1N1 vaccination clinic on Friday, October 30, 2009 from 2:00 pm to 7:00 pm at Sarah Scott Middle School, located at 1017 N. 12<sup>th</sup> Street for the following groups:

- healthy 2-4 year olds
- healthy individuals who are household contacts to (or caregivers of) infants aged 6 months and younger
- healthy healthcare workers 49 and younger who have direct patient contact

A clinic consent form is posted on the MHD website at [www.milwaukee.gov/health](http://www.milwaukee.gov/health) and is available in both English and Spanish. The MHD strongly encourages residents to download and complete the form and bring it with them to the clinic to assist in quicker registration processing.

Approximately 1500 doses of H1N1 intranasal vaccine will be administered to these groups in accordance with the recommendations released by the State Division of Public Health (DPH) on Tuesday. The new recommendations follow reports by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) of significant delays in the production of H1N1 vaccine. The MHD provided over 5400 H1N1 vaccinations to the public this past weekend at clinics held at South Division High School and Sara Scott Middle School.
