



Do your windows look like these?



75% of Milwaukee's lead poisoned children live in these 6 zip codes: 53206, 53208, 53209, 53210, 53212, and 53216

The City of Milwaukee Health Department Lead Abatement Program will provide **\$300 per window** to replace original windows that have lead-based paint.

The City of Milwaukee Healthy Homes Program provides up to **\$5,000** to address asthma triggers if anyone 2-40 years old is diagnosed with asthma

- This offer is for properties built on or before 1950 located in these zip codes: **53206, 53208, 53209, 53210, 53212, and 53216**
- Rental properties must have low-income tenants
- Vacant units must be made available to low-income families
- Owner-occupants must be low-income, have a pregnant woman or children less than 4 years old
- Property taxes must be current
- No open building code violations
- Typical lead abatement grant for a duplex averages **\$8,400**
- Owner pays 10% of costs plus \$57 permit fee
- No copay with Healthy Homes Program
- Owner must be available for inspection with lead inspector
