Family Planning Health Services Emergency Contraception Response Line:

Family Planning-only Services (FPOS)

Formerly known as “Family Planning Waiver”

Free & 100% confidential sexual health & family planning related services for both males and females.

A person may be eligible to enroll in “Family Planning Only Services” if they:

- Are a U.S. Citizen, or have qualifying immigration status
- At least 15 years of age
- Are not enrolled in Medicaid or BadgerCare Plus Standard or Benchmark Plans, and
- Have a family gross income of no more than 300% of the federal poverty level.

Family Size	300% FPL
1	\$2,707.50
2	\$3,642.50

Benefits include:

- Continuous supply of free condoms
- Many contraceptive/birth control options
- Free STD and HIV testing & treatment
- Free emergency contraception
- Free routine sexual health care exams, including pap tests
- Your choice of private medical providers
- Same-day appointments & services are available

Notes for youth 19 & under:

- You do not need to claim your parent’s income when applying. ONLY your personal income is counted towards eligibility.
- If you are unsure about whether you have health insurance coverage through your parent’s, contact any of the enrollment resources below to help you find out.
- You will still be eligible for confidential FPOS services, even if your parents have private health insurance coverage or you are covered by BadgerCare Plus.

- Apply in person: Walk-in; first-come, first served. Same day free services, including EC and free condoms, no appointment needed: Keenan Health Center, 3200 N. Fond du Lac, 414-286-6504
- **Community Health Access Program (CHAP):** offers walk-in, first come, first served enrollment assistance for all BadgerCare Plus/FPOS benefits. **CHAP** is available Monday- Friday at three Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) Health Centers. Call for daily hours 414-286-8620.
- **Milwaukee Men’s Health Center:** offers walk-in enrollment assistance for BadgerCare Plus/FPOS benefits. The Men’s Health Center is available at two MHD health centers. Call for daily hours 414-286-8620
