Mayor Barrett Greets First Arrival of Lake Express in 2015; Milwaukee-Michigan Ferry Service Kicks Off Friday

Lake Express, the high-speed ferry connecting Milwaukee with Muskegon, Michigan launches its 2015 sailing season on Friday, and Milwaukee Mayor Tom Barrett will be there to welcome arriving passengers when the ship docks following its first west-bound crossing.

Lake Express has served travelers across Lake Michigan since 2004 providing a fast and convenient connection with Milwaukee. The service is popular with tourists, vacationers, and business people looking for an alternative to the lengthy drive through Chicago, Indiana, and Michigan.
