The City of Milwaukee, the City's Department of Public Works Department (DPW), and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) are inviting you to a Public Information Meeting where staff will provide information, answer questions and receive input about public bike sharing stations proposed for approximately 30 locations in Downtown Milwaukee and near Downtown neighborhoods.

Conference Room 102 (1st floor – closest entrance is off North Broadway)


This proposed project consists of the purchase and installation of approximately 30 public bike sharing stations at various locations in downtown Milwaukee and near downtown neighborhoods. This proposed expansion of the public bike sharing system is funded by a \$1.6 million federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) grant.

The City of Milwaukee developed a public-private partnership with a local non-profit organization, Bublr Bikes (www.BublrBikes.com), to develop and operate a public bike sharing system in the City of Milwaukee. Currently, there are 11 public bike share stations operating in downtown Milwaukee.
