

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

The City of Milwaukee, Department of Public Works (DPW) and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT), are inviting you to attend a Public Information Meeting where we will provide information regarding the proposed **Replacement of North 51st Boulevard Bridge over Lincoln Creek**. The project is proposed for construction during the summer of 2017.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 4, 2015, from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the Congress Year-round School Auditorium, 5225 West Lincoln Creek Drive, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Representatives from the City of Milwaukee DPW will be available to answer questions.

The proposed improvement consists of removing the existing steel girder bridge and replacing with a new concrete slab bridge. The existing piers and abutments will also be removed and replaced. The bridge is proposed to be widened from 78 feet to 82 feet and lengthened from 104 feet to 117 feet. Approach roadway work will be limited between West Lincoln Creek Drive and West Parkway Drive.

The Lincoln Creek Parkway has been identified as eligible for the National Register of Historic Places as part of the Milwaukee County Park system. As required by section 106 process, indicated in the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) Facilities Development Manual for archaeological/historic review, this notice is to also serve as a formal notification for this project to persons with a concern for or knowledge about historic buildings, structures and archaeological sites located along this project. Such persons are encouraged to attend this meeting or provide comments to the City of Milwaukee.
