Other Important Information:

Minimum Requirements

- (1) Two (2) years of continuous service as a Firefighter or Fire Paramedic in the Milwaukee Fire Department as of **May 12, 2016**. Continuous service includes:
 - a. time spent on military leave or duty disability;
 - b. unpaid absences of 30 cumulative days or fewer for non-disciplinary reasons such as educational leave, physical disability and/or sick leave and;
 - c. absences of five (5) cumulative eight-hour working days or less or two (2) cumulative twenty-four hour working days or less for disciplinary reasons, however the applicant must have the required years of actual service.
- (2) Current State of Wisconsin certification as an EMT-B, including all refresher requirements.
- (3) A valid regular Wisconsin driver's license at time of application and throughout employment.
- (4) Completion of the MFD Professional Development Program upon time of promotion.

Candidates are responsible for ensuring that applications are submitted online by the deadline of **Monday, April 18, 2016**. The FPC is not responsible for applications not received.
