Overall Progress Narrative:

With a strong start in the NSP1 program, Milwaukee will implement very similar activities which will result in stabilization of targeted neighborhoods for NSP 2. The City of Milwaukee is continuing to make significant strides in implementing activities under the NSP 2 Program. Foreclosures are resulting in significant costs for Milwaukee homeowners and neighborhoods. The City's use of a comprehensive strategy to address the problems of foreclosures at all levels, and builds on neighborhood redevelopment initiatives and partnerships to achieve success.

Program guidelines, materials and documents for all of the homebuyer and rental owner assisted activities are being developed. Discussions have begun internally to ensure extensive outreach and informational meetings with local lenders, realtors, homebuyer counseling agencies and developers.
