## **DAY 36**

### **STILL NO INFORMATION RE: DEATH OF FRANK MOORE II**

It's now been 36 days since I first called on Police Chief Nannette Hegerty and District Attorney E. Michael McCann to conduct a thorough investigation into the tragic shooting death of good Samaritan Frank Moore II. In just the past few weeks the Common Council – at my urging – discussed and yesterday gave its final approval to officially renaming a city street in Mr. Moore's honor.

But today Mr. Moore's family continues to wait for the information that could help explain what exactly happened that allowed Mr. Moore's killer to be free to roam the streets when he should have been in jail. In a case like this, sometimes the only thing family members have to look forward to is a phone call with new information from investigators. However, in this case the phone isn't ringing and there are no details coming forth, so Mr. Moore's children, family members and friends must continue their patient vigil.

Again, I remind Milwaukee residents that we must strongly demand accountability from our police and our prosecutors – especially in matters of life and death. There can be no more important aspect of law enforcement and criminal justice accountability than finding the truth and holding that truth in the light for all to see.
